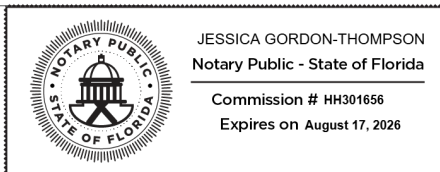

NOTICE OF ORDINANCE NO. 5370

AN ORDINANCE to repeal, recreate, create, and amend various sections of the Code of Ordinances of the City of La Crosse relating to electric bicycles, electric scooters, and other vehicle use.

Please take notice that the above Ordinance was adopted by the Common Council of the City of La Crosse on May 14, 2026. A summary of the subject matter and main points of the ordinance is as follows.

The purpose of the ordinance is to align with state laws and regulations, update language to provide clarity and consolidate redundancies and give definitions which include those relevant to State Law.

Section Specific Changes:

- Section 34-67 amended to eliminate motor vehicle regulation
- Section 34-68 repealed and recreated to regulate bicycles, electric personal assistive mobility devices, electric scooters and other vehicles in City parks
- Section 44-198 repealed and recreated to regulate play vehicles, in-line skates and motorized play vehicles
- Section 44-199 created to regulate electric scooters per State law
- Section 44-200 created to add definitions
- Section 44-223 amended to define the Downtown Area and prohibit e-bike throttle use on sidewalks
