

Resolution requesting assistance from the Wisconsin Waterways Commission for the feasibility and engineering study of a transient dock and recreational boating facility in the City of La Crosse.

RESOLUTION

**WHEREAS**, the Common Council approved Riverside North Plan in 2014, and a public recreational boating facility was part of the approved plan to increase public access to the Black River; and


**WHEREAS**, funding is needed to implement the plan and the Common Council requests assistance with completing a feasibility and engineering study for the proposed \$2 million public transient dock and recreational boating facility at Riverside North; and

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Common Council of the City of La Crosse that it hereby authorizes the Mayor to act on behalf of the City of La Crosse to submit an application to the Wisconsin Waterways Commission for financial assistance; sign documents; and take necessary action to undertake, direct and complete the study.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that if funded, the City of La Crosse will comply with state and federal rules for the program and will work to forward the study through to a completed project. Once completed, the City will maintain the completed project in an attractive and an inviting manner serving both residents and visitors while reasonably maintaining seasonal operations for a facility of this nature.
