NO ACTION TAKEN

Woznak presented attached slides. 500-year floodplain had not previously been modeled, but could help people out. The modeling is showing that 57 houses have the potential to be removed. It is unknown whether lots previously set aside for flood storage could be developed yet. Stormwater ponds may need to remain. The regulatory floodplain modeling (1D) is still a decade away from moving to a 2D model. Whether any homes would be in the floodway depends on the model. Woznak should be ready to present next month again.
