Or "Carbon neutrality in La Crosse looks like ______" The piece will also include a link and QR code connecting community members with the project website as well as a content upload center where community members can upload stories, art, poems, or other materials expressing their input.

Eligibility

Open to all artists and artist teams located within the United States, with priority to artists in close proximity to La Crosse, WI. Artist teams please designate one primary contact person for your group.

The City of La Crosse has committed to carbon neutrality by 2050. It will be developing its first Climate Action Plan for the community throughout 2022. Design Criteria

Artist shall demonstrate the ability to create artwork that is:

- Interactive, eliciting a response from the viewer on its surface and/or electronically
- Either moveable or easily replicate able to be placed in multiple locations
- The artist or artist team's own original work
- Suitable for viewers of all ages
- Designed to withstand adverse Midwestern winter weather including winds, freezing temperatures, and rainfall or heavy wet snow.

- Soundly-constructed and firmly-anchorable to prevent theft or injury
- Constructed of sustainability materials

Budget

The total budget is \$3,500. The budget includes artist fees, site preparation, installation, and maintenance.
