## ORDINANCE NO.: 5229

AN ORDINANCE to amend Section 4-48 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of La Crosse regarding sale of intoxicating liquor.

THE COMMON COUNCIL of the City of La Crosse do ordain as follows:

SECTION I: Section 4-48 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 125.51(3)(b), retail "Class B" licensees are hereby authorized to sell intoxicating liquor in the original package or container, in multiples not to exceed four liters at any one time in any quantity, and to be consumed off the premises where sold. Wine, however, may be sold for consumption off the premises in the original package or otherwise in any quantity. This section does not apply to a winery that has been issued a "Class B" license.

SECTION II: Should any portion of this ordinance be declared unconstitutional or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this division shall not be affected.

SECTION III: This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
