Department Highlights:

- Greg Temp retired April 4th after serving over 30 years with the LCFD (final crew pictured above)
- Community Risk Reduction Educational April events: UWL Kid's College Day, Logan HS Senior Fire Safety, and Childrens' Museum Safety Day

Notable Incidents:

- April 10th, LCFD responded to structure fire at 516 Caledonia Street just after 5:00 am. Upon arrival, crews
 approached the home seeing fire from the side, and quickly rescued one individual. While assuring all residents
 were out, crews rapidly began to extinguish the fire. Firefighters on-scene were able to remove a dog from the
 house and provider life-saving care. The home sustained major damage, displacing two individuals and their
 dog. The cause of this fire is still under investigation.
- April 14th, LCFD responded to a structure fire at 5273 Brackenwood Court at 2:42 pm. Upon arrival, crews
 observed heavy fire and smoke conditions from the residence. The home sustained major damage, displacing
 the family and the fire is still under investigation.
