TYPE OF ALTERATION: Remove Reserved Parking – ADA zone

GENERAL LOCATION: 700 block of 6th Street South, East side

## Report:

A request and application have been received from the American Legion Post No. 52 regarding the feasibility of removing the existing ADA parking spaces on 6<sup>th</sup> Street South adjacent to 711 6<sup>th</sup> Street S. The American Legion will later move the ADA spaces to the section of street on Market street.

It is hereby noted the American Legion constitutes 100% of the footage. It is therefore recommend to remove of the ADA zone as defined above.

**WHEREAS**, Section 44-39 of the City of La Crosse Municipal Code of Ordinances provides that after obtaining a report and recommendation of the Traffic Engineer, the Chief of Police shall forward recommendations and appropriate orders to the Board of Public Works.

**AND WHEREAS**, the Findings of the Traffic Engineer state the public interest, convenience, and necessity, the Chief of Police hereby Orders the above traffic alterations, to wit:

Remove Reserved parking – ADA zone in the 700 block of 6<sup>th</sup> Street S.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the Board of Public Works hereby approves the aforementioned traffic alteration, and City staff is hereby authorized to effect said changes.
