## CITY OF LA CROSSE BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS Findings & Orders:

TYPE OF ALTERATION: Reserved Parking – ADA zone

GENERAL LOCATION: South side of 600 block of Market Street, from a point 45 feet east of the east line of 6<sup>th</sup> Street S, to a point 45 feet easterly thereof.

Report:

A request and application have been received from the American Legion Post No. 52 regarding the feasibility of establishing two ADA parking spaces on Market Street adjacent to 711 6<sup>th</sup> Street S. These two parking spaces will replace the current Loading zone. The parking spaces are adjacent to the new accessible entrance to the building.

It is hereby noted the American Legion constitutes 100% of the footage. It is therefore recommended to establish the ADA parking zones as defined above.

**WHEREAS**, Section 44-39 of the City of La Crosse Municipal Code of Ordinances provides that after obtaining a report and recommendation of the Traffic Engineer, the Chief of Police shall forward recommendations and appropriate orders to the Board of Public Works.

**AND WHEREAS**, the Findings of the Traffic Engineer state the public interest, convenience, and necessity, the Chief of Police hereby Orders the above traffic alterations, to wit:

• Reserved parking – ADA zone in the 600 block of Market Street, as detailed above.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the Board of Public Works hereby approves the aforementioned traffic alteration, and City staff is hereby authorized to effect said changes.
