ORDINANCE NO.: _____

AN AMENDED ORDINANCE to amend Subsection 115-110 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of La Crosse by <u>conditionally</u> transferring certain property from Washburn Residential Neighborhood District to the Traditional Neighborhood District - Specific allowing for continued use of the property as a professional office space at 212 11th Street South.

THE COMMON COUNCIL of the City of La Crosse do ordain as follows:

SECTION I: Subsection 115-110 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of La Crosse is hereby amended by <u>conditionally</u> transferring certain property from the Washburn Residential Neighborhood District to the Traditional Neighborhood District - Specific on the Master Zoning Map, to-wit:

Tax Parcel 17-20187-110; 212 11th St. S.

SECTION II: This rezoning is conditioned upon the following conditions precedent being completed within ninety (90) calendar days of publication of this ordinance:

- <u>That a restrictive covenant be placed on the property and recorded with the La</u> <u>Crosse County Register of Deeds providing that the following uses of the property</u> <u>are prohibited:</u>
 - (a) Methadone clinic
 - (b) <u>Sheltering services, including overnight</u>
 - (c) Needle exchange program
 - (d) Drug detoxification program.
- (2) That the restrictive covenant also contain the following provisions:
 - (a) <u>The restrictive covenant may not be amended or removed without a written</u> <u>document signed and approved by the City of La Crosse Common Council.</u>
 - (b) <u>The ability to enforce the restrictive covenant is granted to any aggrieved</u> property owner in the neighborhood, the City of La Crosse, or any combination <u>thereof.</u>
 - (c) <u>The restrictive covenant shall run with the land and shall be binding and enforceable against the property owner and any and all heirs, successors, agents and assigns.</u>

<u>SECTION III:</u> Should any portion of this ordinance be declared unconstitutional or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this division shall not be affected.

SECTION HIV: This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
