

Resolution to authorize Sanitary Sewer Utility to purchase used dump truck from the Street Department.

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Sanitary Sewer Utility has a dump truck that historically has been used to haul grit and biosolids to the La Crosse County landfill; and

WHEREAS, as part of the recent upgrades at the Wastewater Treatment Plant (WWTP), a new drying process was implemented that creates heat dried biosolids that can be later utilized as fertilizer. However, spoils from this process have created additional use for this truck to haul unusable material to the landfill; and

WHEREAS, the current 2000 Chevy C8500 dump truck (WWU-TDT-15) is in need of significant repairs to continue safely being used on the highway and needs to be replaced as to not incur repairs that may far exceed the value of said vehicle; and

WHEREAS, the Street Department has a 2003 Sterling 7501 dump truck (STR-TDT-21) that they will sell to the Sanitary Sewer Utility for \$10,000; and

WHEREAS, the 2024 Capital Equipment budget would need to be amended, and would be paid for from sanitary sewer utility funds; and

WHEREAS, Section 2-360(c) of the Code of Ordinances states any Capital Project and Capital Equipment item not previously listed in the adopted Capital Budget requiring immediate funding from the Capital Budget will require a two-thirds vote of the Common Council members present at the meeting; and


WHEREAS the Sanitary Sewer Utility will sell the old dump truck to offset the cost of purchasing the used truck from the Street Department.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City of La Crosse that it hereby authorizes the Sanitary Sewer Utility to purchase the used dump truck from the Street Department in the amount of \$10,000.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Utilities Finance & Compliance Manager and the Director of Finance are hereby authorized and directed to take all necessary steps to implement this resolution.
