Resolution approving release of 2016 CIP funds for bicycle and pedestrian plan implementation projects

## RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the City's approved 2012 *Bicycle and Pedestrian Master Plan* includes maps (p. 119-126) and tables of objectives (p. 169-190) for infrastructure improvements along with their costs:

WHEREAS, the Bicycle-Pedestrian Advisory Committee accepted the recommendations of bicycle advocates for priority improvements on which to spend CIP funds at their February 21, 2017 meeting,

WHEREAS, the 2016-2020 Capital Improvement Program includes \$50,000 in 2016 for bicycle & pedestrian plan implementation funding (Item 203) and a resolution to release those funds was not introduced in 2016;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Common Council of La Crosse that it hereby authorizes the release of \$50,000 from the 2016-A Promissory Note (Streets) for the following improvements:

- Priority 1B: Directional signage for bicycle boulevards on King (BC124), Farnam (BC074), 17<sup>th</sup> (BC160), 22<sup>nd</sup> (BC026 & BC053), and Avon (BC128)
- Priority 2 (Highly Recommended): Directional signage at 15<sup>th</sup>/Vine (BC019), East (BC020), Pine (BC021), 16<sup>th</sup> (BC022), Main/Bliss (BC023), 29<sup>th</sup> (BC028), Fanta Reed (BC035 & BC036), Fishermans (BC037), Spillway Road (BC038), and Salem (BC040)
- Priority 2 (Recommended Partial):Direction signage at Green Bay (BC016 & BC060), Cliffwood (BC057), 28<sup>th</sup> (BC058 & BC059), Various East Side (BC062), and Birch (BC069).

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Engineer and Director of Finance are hereby authorized to take any and all steps necessary to effectuate this resolution.
