Commencing at the Southeast corner of Block 12 of McConnell \& Whittlesey's Addition, said point being located on the North right of way line of St. James Street and the West right of way line of Kane Street; thence East along the North right of way line of St. James Street, 25' to the point of beginning; thence North, 66.5' more or less on a line parallel with the West right of way line of Kane Street to the North line of the SE $1 / 4$ of the NW $1 / 4$ of Section 29; thence East along said North line 20 feet; thence South, 66.5' more or less on a line parallel with the West right of way line of Kane Street to the intersection with the North right of way line of St. James Street; thence West along said North line 20 feet to the point of beginning.
