WHEREAS, Mayor Kabat has signed the Mayors for 100% Clean Energy Endorsement supporting the goal of 100% clean, renewable energy in our city and is a member of the bipartisan Climate Mayors, committed to adopt, honor and uphold Paris Climate Agreement goals.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City of La Crosse that it adopts the following sustainability goals: 1) Achieve municipality and community carbon neutrality by 2050 with incremental drawdown targets of 5% by 2020, 20% by 2025, 30% by 2030, 45% by 2035, 60% by 2040, 80% by 2045, and 100% by 2050. 2) Obtain 100% renewable energy by 2050 for the municipality and city, utilizing all available economic incentives and technical assistance.
