Resolution appropriating utility funds to pay for the water and sanitary sewer design for South Avenue from Green Bay Street to Ward Avenue.

## RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the La Crosse Common Council has entered into a State Municipal Agreement to reconstruct South Avenue from Green Bay Street to Ward Avenue; and

WHEREAS, both water and sanitary sewer infrastructure needs to be replaced; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Common Council of the City of La Crosse hereby approves authorizing the sum of \$35,000 appropriated from water utility funds and the sum of \$35,000 appropriated from sanitary sewer utility funds.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Director of Engineering and Public Works is authorized to sign a contract with Mead and Hunt, Inc. for the utility design on the South Avenue project.

BE IT FURTHE RESOLVED that all funds paid on this contract to date shall be paid back by the respective utilities, each paying half.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City of La Crosse that the Director of Finance & Human Resources and Director of Engineering & Public Works are hereby authorized to effectuate this resolution.
