Dear Mr. Reinhart:

The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) and City of La Crosse are conducting the above highway project along USH 14/South Avenue in the City of La Crosse. As part of the real estate process, five on-premise signs will be affected. WisDOT proposes to realign each sign on the remaining lands of the owners pursuant to the provisions of s. 84.30(5r), Stats., in order to avoid any possible damages to the real property resulting from the loss of the signs. A notice to that effect for each sign is included with this letter.

Per Wis. Stat. s. 84.30(5r), you are required to decide whether the City of La Crosse will allow these signs to be moved on the same parcels, so that the signs can be realigned on the owner's remaining properties, or request WisDOT to acquire the sign structures. If the city requests WisDOT to acquire any of the signs, WisDOT will be responsible for the cost of moving the structure or cost to acquire the structure, whichever is less. All remaining costs resulting from the acquisition of the sign would be paid by the City of La Crosse, including any loss in value to the to the owner's real estate caused by the elimination of the sign. See Wis. Stat. s. 84.30(5r)(c).
