



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
# OVERALL FINISH PLAN - ARENA LEVEL




Color Coded Floor Finish Plan - Mezzanine/Office Levels







# CONCESSIONS




Material selections extend into the arena concourse, employed as a wayfinding tool to highlight concession areas.


## EAST CONNECTION CORRIDOR




This area emphasizes connection. As the primary transition from existing to new, materials are subtle yet durable to protect surfaces.

# PRE-FUNCTION



> The pre-function space is designed to capture surrounding views. Dynamic lighting illuminates the La Crosse Center as a beacon of activity.




Linear ceiling feature inspired by log driving along The Mississippi, an homage to the evolving story of La Crosse.
