QUOTE FORM – 2020 BRIDGE INSPECTIONS

The City of La Crosse is seeking professional engineering services to conduct routine inspections of 16 City bridges that carry vehicular or pedestrian traffic. The list of specific bridges to be inspected is attached. Qualified engineering firms or individuals interested in providing these services to the City should complete this form and submit it to the City's Engineering Dept. at 400 La Crosse St. by 3:00 p.m. on Thursday February 6, 2020. Quotes may be submitted via US Mail, e-mail or they may be delivered. Only quotes from qualified firms or individuals will be accepted.

Inspections need to be completed in accordance with the Wisconsin D.O.T. Bureau of Structures Maintenance & Inspections Policy by a certified Bridge Inspector listed in the Highway Structures Information System (H.S.I.) as an "Active" inspector with an inspector I.D. number.

The work needs to be completed and inspection data entered into H.S.I. System between April 2 and April 30, 2020.

Upon completion of the work and prior to April 30, 2020 an electronic copy of each inspection report, including all photographs, drawings, and other pertinent documents, shall be submitted to the City's Engineering Dept.

Any proposed departures from the specified inspection procedures must accompany all quotes.

The City of La Crosse reserves the right to reject all quotes or to accept any quote it deems to be in the best interests of the City, and to waive any quote technicality or irregularity.
