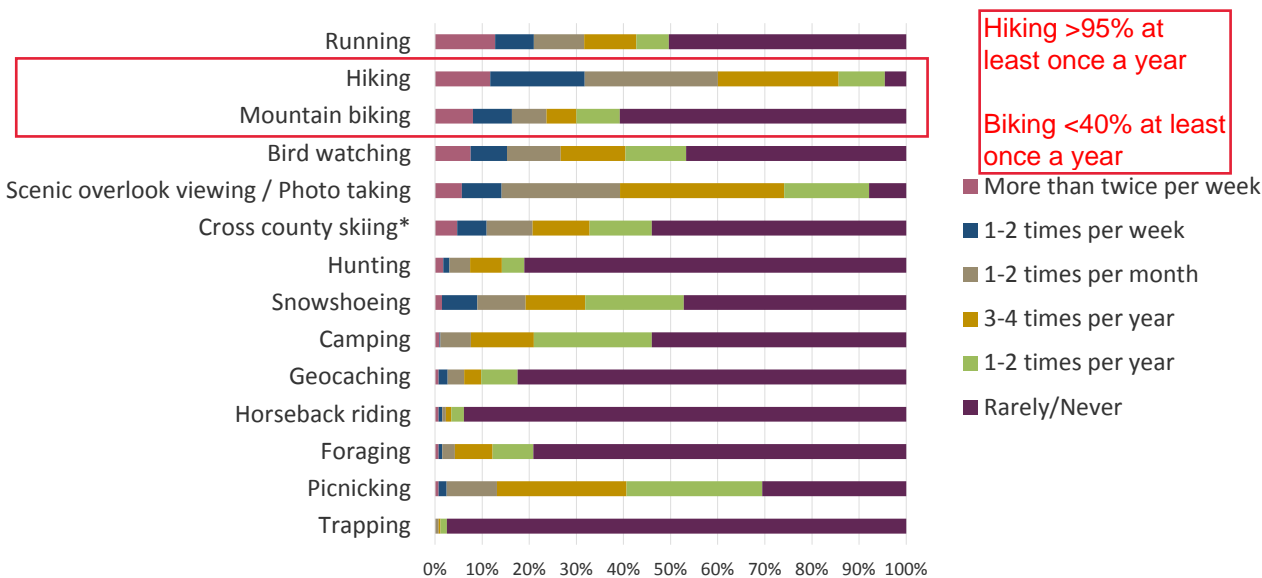


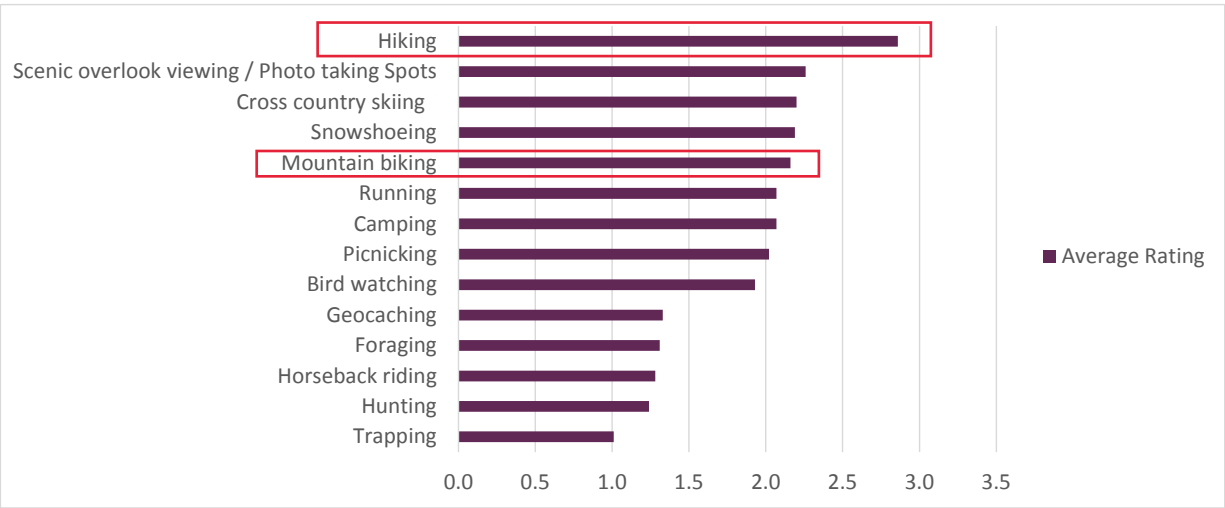
How often respondents do the following activities in the region

According to survey respondents, the most popular types of recreation (based on the reported frequency of the activity) are hiking, running, mountain biking and bird watching. Activities that respondents rarely/never engage in include trapping, horseback riding, geocaching and hunting, among others.

When asked what type of recreational opportunities there should be *more* of in the blufflands, the top response was hiking. Other popular responses included scenic overlooks/photo taking spots, mountain biking, snowshoeing and cross country skiing. Respondents preferred both active (hiking, mountain biking, etc.) and passive recreational activities (bird watching, scenic overlooks, etc.).
