


This easement is granted on the following conditions:

- 1. The above grade structures, such as buildings, fences, towers, power poles, bill boards, or any other structure that impedes or redirects the flow of storm water run-off are not permitted in the easement without approval of the City of La Crosse, Board of Public Works and the Town of Campbell.
- 2. Town of Campbell may, at the Town's option, cut brush and trees and/or mow grass and weeds in drainage easement.
- 3. If the Town of Campbell disturbs grassed areas for maintenance, replacement or removal, the Town will restore with seed and/or sod at the Town's expense within three weeks of when the disturbance occurred.
- 4. Concrete rubble, asphalt rubble, stone or rock exceeding 6" in the largest dimension, demolition debris or other rubble shall not be placed within the easement.
- 5. This easement is created for conveyance of storm water run-off.
- 6. The City of La Crosse may terminate such easement with 60 days notice to the Town of Campbell.
- 7. The Town of Campbell agrees to work with the City of La Crosse for future storm water needs downstream of this easement and agrees to share in the costs of future construction and maintenance projects downstream of this easement on a flow proportional basis.


