Resolution creating the Committee for Citizens with Disabilities.

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, residents of our community have differing abilities and deserve equal access and treatment; and

WHEREAS, the Committee for Citizens with Disabilities will work to ensure that City facilities and resources are accessible to all and will strive to create a community that values and respects people of all abilities; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that said Committee be comprised of up to (9) members, including one (1) Common Council Member and eight (8) citizen members appointed by the Mayor and approved by the Common Council.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that City Staff is authorized to take all steps necessary to effectuate this resolution.
