

**NOTICE OF HEARING ON  
AMENDMENT TO ZONING RESTRICTION**

TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Common Council of the City of La Crosse, by its Judiciary & Administration Committee, will hold a public hearing on a proposed ordinance change in the zoning code as follows:

**AN ORDINANCE to amend Subsection 115-110 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of La Crosse transferring certain property from the Multiple Dwelling District to the Commercial and Light Industrial allowing continued use of a community center and school with an addition to the maintenance shop at 1305, 1321 and 1415 St. James Street.**

**Property is presently used for: Boy's & Girls Club, Margaret Annett Head Start and La Crosse County Housing Authority Maintenance Shop.**

**Property is proposed to be used for: All three properties are proposed have the same uses, with an addition proposed for the maintenance shop. Rezoning will provide better flexibility and is required in order to add the addition.**

Said property is further described as follows:

*Tax Parcel No. 17-10300-395. REDCLOUD ADDITION E1/2 OF PLAYGROUND*

A public hearing before the Judiciary & Administration Committee will be held at **6:00 p.m. on Tuesday, September 29, 2020** in the Council Chambers in City Hall, City of La Crosse, Wisconsin.

Final action will be determined by the **Common Council on Thursday, October 8, 2020 at 6:00 p.m.** in the Council Chambers in City Hall, City of La Crosse, Wisconsin.

Any person interested may be heard for or against such proposed change, and may appear in person, by attorney or may file a formal objection, which objection forms are available in the City Clerk's Office.
