Resolution amending the Appendix C Fee Schedule related to the Extension of Outdoor Café Program.

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, in response to the impact that the COVID-19 pandemic has had on restaurants in our community, the City of La Crosse is committed to assisting businesses; and

WHEREAS, temporarily allowing restaurants and to expand their outdoor seating will aid in the recovery of the local economy while adhering to Public Health Orders from the La Crosse County Health Department; and

WHEREAS, the Outdoor Café Program sunsets on November 13, 2020 and there is a desire and request from the business community to allow the program to exist through the winter months; and

WHEREAS, the Outdoor Café Program Guidelines and Application have been revised accordingly and is scheduled for consideration by the Judiciary & Administration and Common Council.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Common Council of the City of La Crosse that it hereby waives the following fees from Appendix C- Fee Schedule under the Outdoor Café Program.
