BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the cost and installation of the UV Filtration Systems from the quote received is \$74,110.00 and \$810 for contingency

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the sum of \$75,000.00 is hereby appropriated as follows:

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Transit Manager and Director of Finance and Purchase, or his/her representative, are authorized to take any and all steps necessary to effectuate this resolution.
