Resolution authorizing the City to terminate its Stage 3 remedial measures as defined by its adopted Economic Recession Plan.

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the City of La Crosse approved an Economic Recession Plan by Resolution #20-0608 in May of 2020 wherein five Stages of economic downturns and revenue shortfalls were defined; and

WHEREAS, the City at that time authorized its placement into a Phase 3 remedial action phase to address its estimated revenue shortfalls in Resolution #20-0608; and

WHEREAS, the Plan required any remedial actions defined as Stages 3-5 required the consent and resolution of the Common Council; and

WHEREAS, the Plan required any subsequent termination or reduction of Stages 3-5 action measures be subject to the same consent and resolution of the Common Council; and

WHEREAS, the City implemented expenditure cuts throughout 2020 to address its shortfalls as defined in Resolution #20-0731 and subsequently built its 2021 Operating Budget based on the new reality of lower projected revenues it's no longer necessary to remain in Stage 3 of the Economic Recession Plan.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City of La Crosse that it hereby authorizes the termination of Stage 3 remedial measures as defined by the Economic Recession Plan

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor and Director of Finance & Human Resources are authorized to take any and all steps necessary to effectuate this resolution.
