Resolution establishing requirements and process for ADA On-Street Parking Zones.

## RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, there is a need for ADA on-street parking zones; and

WHEREAS, said ADA parking zones are authorized pursuant to Section 44-39(c) of the Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS, Section 44-39(c) identifies that ADA on-street parking zones requirements shall be established by resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City of La Crosse that it hereby approves the following requirements and process established for ADA onstreet parking zones.

- 1. ADA parking zones shall be subject to the following requirements:
  - (a) Designated zone is less than 100' from an existing ADA compliant corner
  - (b) No alley access
  - (c) No existing time limit parking zone on the block
  - (d) No available off-street parking (less than 10' from building to lot line)
  - (e) Has existing sidewalk
- 2. ADA parking zones shall be allowed in Residential Zoning Districts only and limited to one space per address.
- 3. ADA parking zones shall remain open to the public for any ADA or Disabled Veteran license plate or permit.
- 4. Application shall be submitted by the property owner and applicant must provide an ADA or Disabled Veteran vehicle license number (permanent).
- 5. Applicant must comply with Section 2-292 of the La Crosse Municipal Code.
- 6. ADA parking zones shall be renewed annually on or about March 1<sup>st</sup>.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Police Department and City Engineering Department are authorized to take any and all steps necessary to effectuate this Resolution.
