



2022 Camping Contract Addendum

Because Pettibone Resort campground is in a floodway we must comply with City and DNR requirements. The goal is to have clean, uncluttered campsites, non intrusive to nature and easy to evacuate in the event of a flood.

To follow is a list of rules and guidelines to reach that goal:

- Nothing can impede the pulling out of a unit
- Trees, bushes and flowers are welcome if they do not impede moving of unit. Please check for approval first. No trimming or removal of trees or bushes without management approval.
- Minimal bark allowed around trees and flowers (Max: 1 bag)
- Firewood piles must be small (3' wide x 3' long x 3'high) Brown tarps only
- Gas tanks and lawn mowers cannot be stored on site
- Refrigerators and golf cart batteries cannot be stored on site
- Edging is not allowed unless approved by Mark or Rory
- Gazebos or fences are not allowed
- Step ways/walkways can be made out of limestone and must be approved
- 1 exterior storage locker per site
- 1 flag and/or satellite can be attached to camper, but must be easy to remove and not permanent
- 2 flower pots and 1 birdfeeder suggested
- No yard art allowed
- Outdoor carpeting or mats are not allowed
- Do not attach any items to trees including nails, screws, etc
- Clotheslines may be up only when in use
- If you want to post a sign it must be on your unit
- All campers must be in working order with current license plates displayed and road ready at all times
- No wood, concrete or steel steps allowed. Suggested steps are aluminum or those attached to the camper.
