Michelle from WI DOT provided updates on the WIS 35 Corridor Study. The study limits are 4.8 miles from HWY 14/61 to HWY 35. Focusing on the following,

- Safety Improvements
- Traffic Operating Improvements
- Multimodal Improvements
- Pavement Replacement
- Bridge Maintenance

The timeline is 01/2024-02/2025 study corridor, 03/2025-12/2026 roadway design, 2027 start construction. The study found within this corridor there were 34 bicycle crashes and 26 pedestrian crashes from 2015-2019. Potential spot improvements to consider are,

- Raised Crosswalks
- Pedestrian Hybrid Beacon
- Raised Intersections
- Angled Median Cut Through

There will be a public hearing held in November of 2024.
