

To whom it may concern,

I am writing to formally request a permit for a 5k run/walk event in honor of Jack Pronschinske. This event will take place on 10/3/26, and the route will primarily pass through the marsh, starting and ending at the Myrick Park Gun shelter.

Please find an attached map outlining the route. Below is a brief description of the course:

Start: The race will begin at the Myrick Park Gun Shelter located at 789 Myrick Park Drive La Crosse WI 54601.

Route: Participants will proceed along the following route:

From the gun shelter, north through the marsh area where an aid station will be set up as runners ascend out of the marsh. From there, they will turn south onto Lang Drive. From Lang Drive, runners run south to La Crosse Street.

At La Crosse Street, runners will take a left onto La Crosse Street. While we do not anticipate any traffic disruptions at this corner, a race volunteer will be stationed to ensure runners do not cross the street.

As runners continue East on La Crosse Street towards the marsh, they will pass through the intersections of La Crosse Street and East Avenue, and continue East to Hillview Avenue.

At Hillview Avenue, runners will turn left and run North on Hillview Avenue, enter Myrick Park and finish at the gun shelter.

Traffic Control:

As noted, a volunteer will provide directions to runners at the intersections of Lang Drive and La Crosse Street.

At the intersection of La Crosse St and East Avenue, we will plan to have a volunteer to assist with the crosswalk

At the intersection of La Crosse St and Hillview Avenue, a volunteer will provide direction to runners.

We do not anticipate significant traffic disruptions, but we want to ensure the safety of all our participants and pedestrians. If necessary, we are happy to discuss any additional arrangements or requirements to ensure the event runs smoothly.

Thank you for your time and consideration of our request. We are excited to honor Jack for a second year.
