## BPAC Subcommittee notes:

### **Infrastructure:**

- Should consider quick-build projects
  - Grants can be used for quick build
- Mixed opinions in group on whether to prioritize greenways or PBL projects
  - Greenways considered priority by some as they typically receive less push back
- Group agreed that projects should focus on areas of key services
- Better bike parking
- Wayfinding

### **Priority projects brought forward by group include:**

- Clinton Street protected bike lanes
- Ranger Drive protected bike lanes
- 22<sup>nd</sup> Street Greenway
- Farnam Street Greenway
- Moore Street Greenway

### **Projects from plan that are moving forward or are already being pursued:**

- Avon Street Greenway (received 2023 TAP grant)
- King Street Greenway (reapply for 2025 TAP grant cycle)

### **Projects in plan that have possibility of being worked in to existing or unfunded CIP requests (Streets or Utilities):**

- Weston Street Greenway
  - Item 229 in CIP
  - Weston Street from East Ave to 21<sup>st</sup> Place is slotted for street reconstruction in 2028
- Farnam Street Greenway
  - Farnam from 16th to 20th is in unfunded for reconstruction
- Vine Street bikeway
  - Front to second street unfunded for reconstruction
- 22<sup>nd</sup> Street Greenway
  - Hyde to Weston unfunded for reconstruction
- 10<sup>th</sup> Street Greenway
  - 10<sup>th</sup> Street Pine to Main Street slotted for street reconstruction in 2029

- Monitor Street bikeway
  - Slotted for reconstruction in 2028

### **Education priority initiatives:**

- Bike Map
- Bike ride upon completion of projects (Route 1 signage, Wagon Wheel Trail, etc.)
- Bike Ped Counts
  - LAPC is applying for grant for multiple Mio-vision traffic counter locations
- Bike Parking
- Pedestrian improvements that connect users to transit services

### **Next Steps:**

- Discuss and narrow down to 1-2 priority projects to seek funding for in CIP and future grant applications
  - Or prioritize list by order of implementation
- Reach out to Explore La Crosse regarding foldable bike map possibility
- Staff will work on bike map possibilities through GIS and the website
- Organize volunteer bike counts while pursuing funding for automated counters
- Establish where and what kind of bike parking is needed
  - Bike parking audit?
- Walking audit for transit services
  - Led by LTTA?
- Establish protocol for wayfinding campaign
