## Find out if you're eligible for an energy assessment to reduce your energy bills!



If you earn less than the chart below, and if your home's energy bills are more than you like, you can qualify for

funds from the City of La Crosse and State to have an energy assessment done on your house. You can be <u>either</u> an owner or a renter (but landlord must be the one to call for scheduling)

- Your home has forced air and you have 12 months of energy bills
- You must be a La Crosse city resident
- You must have written approval from your landlord if you are not the legal owner of the property

If your house fits the **above list**, and you own the home (provided the home is owner occupied), and <u>either you or your</u> tenants earn less than below, you could be eligible for a grant to assess your home's energy waste, reduce energy bills and make the home more comfortable!

Please note, windows are NOT available as part of this program!
