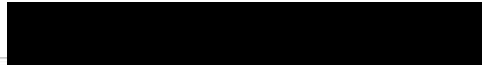


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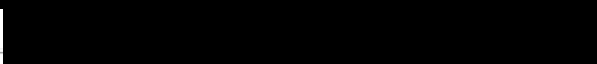

Drive to LaX often. Not enough parking! People that ride bicycles aren't shopping.

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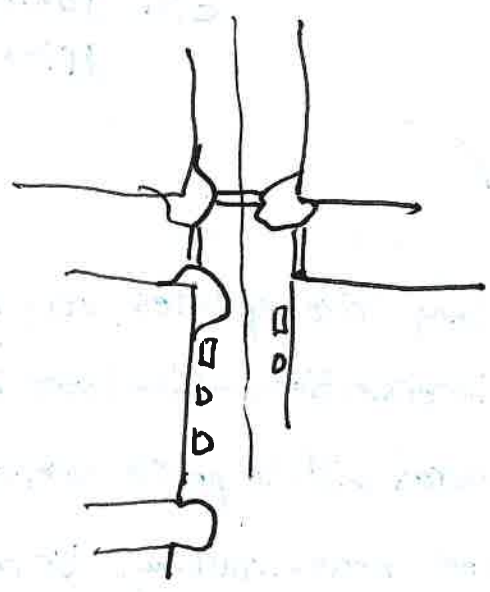

Additional Comments on Amendment to the Bicycle and Pedestrian Master Plan:

Lang Drive updates very much appreciated. Love protected intersections + bike lanes idea. Traffic moves so quickly and there's wildlife people swerve for (turtles mainly) so biking there feels nerve-wracking. We really need improved pedestrian crossings along state st. by UWL (13th-16th). Parked cars along the road make it very difficult to see pedestrians until they are fully in the roadway. Additionally Losey feels so unsafe along the whole stretch practically. Cars drive 10 over and there's so many driveways people whip in and out of. It definitely needs further evaluation to feel safe for bikers + pedestrians. On the whole, I love the new additions to the plan. I think if they are achieved La Crosse will be more safe for everyone.

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- as a student, I appreciate a safe connection from the UW-L campus to downtown → I think the improvements to Vine St. would be good
- having ways to get from campus for students who don't have a car but need to go to the grocery store, etc.
- not a great way to get ~~from~~ between northern + south side to Crosse
- bike lanes on 2nd St. are very nice + make you feel a lot safer as a rider, would love to see more of those on more traveled roads
- would love to see more crossing lights on places like West Ave. ~~and~~ Losey

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We believe Redfield Street is the wrong place for a bike lane/greenway. Too much traffic by Longfellow School as is, adding bike traffic could be a dangerous situation for everyone. Adams Street might be a better choice. Straight shot to State Road to tie into existing bike lane without dangerous intersection of Redfield and Casey Blvd. I ask that you please reconsider using Redfield Street for this.
