

New planting **Please explain:** I would like to replace the grass with native plants on the boulevard on my property. This is a very sunny and dry location, and the grass has not done well. A selection of full sun/dry soilloving native plants will thrive in this location. **Project plan and materials:** See page 2 for a sample design. Materials: Materials used may include supplementary soil/compost, mulch, and low-profile edging to separate the end of my boulevard area from my neighbor's boulevard. **Plant List:** All plants used will be native and no taller than 30 inches. A goal is to include plants that support pollinators from early spring to late fall. Possibilities include: Butterfly Weed (Asclepias tuberosa), Prairie Dropseed (Sporobulus heterolepis), Hairy Beardtongue (Penstemon hirsutus), Cream Wild Indigo (Baptisia bracteate), Nodding Onion (Allium cernuum), Cliff Goldenrod (Solidago sciaphila), Old Field Goldenrod (Solidago nemoralis), Pasque Flower (Anemone patens var. wolfgangiana), and/or native species of similar height and sun/soil requirements. I will also try to choose plants that are salt-tolerant. Maintenance Plan: I am an experienced gardener and enjoy building and maintaining my home gardens. I will plant low-maintenance native plants in this location. I will provide supplementary water as needed, and will maintain the garden appropriately for the safety and accessibility of pedestrians/motorists and the support of the environment/pollinators.
